



## Neighborhood Leaf Cleanup

Vista Oaks Neighborhood LEAF CLEAN-UP is scheduled for Wednesday, November 29<sup>th</sup>, December 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>th</sup>. Central Texas Refuse, the MUD's contractor for solid waste removal, will collect **unlimited bags** of yard trimmings, leaves, and bundled limbs.

- **When will this happen?** The unlimited collection of Paper Lawn Leaf Bags and bundled limbs will be picked up for four consecutive weeks on your normal scheduled pick-up day: **Wednesday, November 29<sup>th</sup>, December 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>th</sup>.**
- **Where can I purchase the paper lawn and leaf bags?** Walmart, Target, Home Depot, and Lowes.
- **Why do I have to use paper lawn leaf bags?** The Paper Lawn Leaf Bags and bundled limbs are being taken to a wood recycling facility. This reduces the amount being disposed of in landfills.
- **Do I have to purchase the bags?** No. Lawn trimmings and leaves placed in **plastic** bags will be picked up. However, **PLASTIC BAGS ARE LIMITED TO SIX BAGS** and plastic bags will be taken to the landfill and will not be recycled. **ALL** lawn trimmings and leaves in paper lawn and leaf bags will be collected and recycled.
- **Can I place unlimited paper lawn and branch bundles - in addition to six items - outside the cart?** Yes!
- Tree limbs **must be bundled with rope or twine**
  - Limbs must not exceed 4" in diameter
  - Limbs must not exceed 4' in length
  - No palm trees or cacti limbs will be accepted
  - No Tree Stumps will be accepted
